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## MARSEILLE TO CIVITAVECCHIA SMALL SHIP CRUISE

### ITINERARY

Days 1 - 2 Marseille , France

Marseille is France's oldest city and one of the Mediterranean's premier ports. Amid the big-city bustle, the old port is a quaint landscape of historic charm: colorful fishing boats sail past the imposing Fort Saint-Jean, narrow streets wander among ancient churches and cobbled squares, while the venerable Basilica overlooks the scene from the hilltop above.

Day 3 Barcelona, Spain

Barcelona is a vibrant city on the northeastern coast of Spain known for its stunning architecture, and rich cultural heritage.

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Barcelona's seaside beauty, sprawling beaches, eclectic architecture, world-class tapas and Tempranillo are all reasons to fall in love with the city of Gaudi. Indeed, the treasures here are many and diverse, captivating travelers and experts alike. In fact, nine important sites in the city, seven designed by the famed architect himself, have earned the acclaim of UNESCO.
