Day 3. 22nd May - Sanary-sur-Mer

France's sunniest city, located on the French Riviera, was originally a small fishing village and still is adorned by a large collection of traditional wooden fishing boats. This is the home of a group of local artisan fisherman who sell their catch daily





on the pier and where Jacques Cousteau had a residence, the Villa Baobab.
