PREMIUM 6 NIGHT TROGIR RETURN CRUISE

A terrific cruise that takes in Mljet National Parks, the islands of Vis, Korcula and Hvar, and the wonderful cities of Split and Dubrovnik. Our small ships can access all of these ports, most of which larger vessels cannot go near. We will cruise in the mornings, stopping in a secluded bay for a swim on the way, and after lunch on board we have time to explore our destinations (where we will moor overnight). In the evenings you are free to try some of the many restaurants and cafes that line these historic harbours.



ITINERARY

Day 1 TROGIR ARRIVAL, Sunday (WR, D)

Embarkation starts at 13:00h. Get settled in your cabin before we set sail at 14:00h to Milna on the Island of Bra also known as the most beautiful and most protected port on Bra. Explore this Dalmatian town dominated by a Baroque church with a typical Dalmatian bell tower. The interior of the church is rich in valuable paintings by Venetian painters. Tonight we are attending a Welcome Reception followed by dinner.

Overnight on Bra Island.

Note: Due to the limited capacity of the Trogir harbour the port of call may be substituted with one of the nearby harbours.

Day 2 BRA ISLAND – KOR ULA, Monday (B, L)

Early in the morning we set sail for the island of Korula, with a swim stop, if weather permits, in one of pristine bays, time to relax and lunch on board. Korula, the most preserved medieval town, and birthplace of the famous explorer Marco Polo. Upon



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arrival take a walking tour of Korcula that takes you through its narrow, cobbled streets. Evening is free to explore the town on your own.

Day 3 KORULJA - DUBROVNIK, Tuesday (B, L)

In the morning, we continue our adventure by sailing to Dubrovnik with lunch on board with stop for swimming, if weather permits. Upon arrival in Dubrovnik, you will enjoy a guided tour at the historical centre of Dubrovnik, walk through Stradun - both a street and a square, the most famous place inside the town walls, the famous city enlisted as UNESCO's World Heritage site, where your guide will show you the most interesting sights of Dubrovnik. After city tour, free time to explore the city, visit City Walls, the Franciscan Monastery with Europe's second oldest pharmacy, the Rector's Palace and the Cathedral, or take a boat ride to Lokrum island or take the cable car to the top of the Mount Srd. Overnight in Dubrovnik.

Day 4 DUBROVNIK - MLJET National Park, Wednesday (B, L, CD)

In the morning, we sail towards Mljet. Croatian "Greenest Island" with its beautiful, untouched nature and its cultural heritage. We arrive in the heart of Mljet National Park which encompasses five types of forests, many species of birds and two deep lakes. If you want to visit Mljet National Park, walk to the entrance where you can purchase the ticket to walk around the Veliko Jezero (Big Lake) and the Malo Jezero (Small Lake) and join the boat ride to St. Mary Island. Tonight, enjoy Captain's dinner and overnight on Island of Mljet.

Day 5 MLJET National Park - HVAR ISLAND, Thursday (B, L)

In the morning, we sail towards Hvar with a break for swimming, if weather permits. Upon arrival in Hvar, you will be visiting many historical sights of the town, such as St Stephen's Square and

Cathedral, the Arsenal with the theatre built on its first floor, the first municipal theatre in Europe. Above the town is the impressive fortress Fortica offering magnificent views over the bay and Pakleni islands. Your evening is free in Hvar. Note: Due to the limited capacity of the Hvar harbour the port of call may be substituted with one of the nearby harbours

Day 6 HVAR ISLAND - TROGIR, Friday (B, L)

After breakfast we set sail to the UNESCO-listed city of Trogir sometimes referred to as "miniature Venice" or a "mini-Dubrovnik" because of its ancient walls, or a floating museum town - as it has a masterful architecture including some stunning Venetian palaces. Get settled in your cabin before going on a short sightseeing tour through this medieval city. Overnight in Trogir.

Day 7 TROGIR DEPARTURE, Saturday (B)

Disembark after breakfast, no later than 9:00h.

M/S Princess Aloha was built in 2013. Maximum capacity is 36 passengers in 16 twin or double beds cabins and 2 triple cabins. All cabins have been built by up-to-date standards, each, fully equipped with A/C, LCD TV, safe deposit box, fire alarm, internal communication system between rooms. Bathrooms are equipped with toilet, shower, wash basin, also included is hair dryer and for added convenience cosmetic package. All cabins are sound-proof and each cabin comes with the fire-proof doors, guaranteeing privacy for all guests. The restaurant area is fully air-conditioned for passengers comfort. A portion of the dining area extends outdoors, offering sweeping panoramic views of the surroundings area and it can accommodate all passengers at once. The restaurant includes bar area with LCD TV, there is also a corner table for buffet breakfast. There is also free wireless internet access (Wi-Fi). The lounging sundeck has a total surface of 2,368 square feet, partially offering sun-shade cover and providing deck-beds for all passengers. The ship has a rear access platform to the sea as well as ladders for easy access to the water. In addition, the vessel offers two outdoor showers and four deck lavatories. Electricity on board: 220V.

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
